

Worried about the cost of medication?

You are not alone.

The BC government's Pharmacare Plans may be able to reduce your prescription costs significantly.



Get help paying for your medication

You can get help to cover the costs of prescription medications through provincial drug plans. The largest plan is an income based plan called **Fair PharmaCare**.

Am I eligible?

Fair PharmaCare is based on your income. The less a family earns, the more help they receive.

All BC residents are eligible if they:

- Have a Personal Health Number (look on the back of your driver's license or Service BC card)
- Let PharmaCare check their income with the Canada Revenue Agency

Coverage is available for:

- Single person
- Marries for common-law couple
- Single person with dependent children
- Couple with dependent children

Some people may need to provide extra information:

- New residents to Canada
- British Columbians who have been living and working overseas
- People turning 19
- People who were exempt from filing a Canadian tax return for the past two years

What do I need to register?

- Your Personal Health Number (PHN)
- Family member PHNs
- Birthdates for each member of your immediate family
- Your social insurance number (SIN)
- Your spouse's SIN (if applicable)
- Your and your spouse's net income from two years ago (line 236 and/or 125 of tax returns)

Plan W

Plan W is designed to meet the unique needs of B.C. First Nations. Plan W covers 100 percent of:

- Eligible prescription costs
- Certain medical supplies
- Certain over-the-counter drugs
- Some natural health products
- Pharmacy services

You are eligible for coverage under the Plan W if you:

- Have active Medical Services
 Plan (MSP) coverage. To enroll
 in MSP, contact the First
 Nations Health Authority
 (FNHA).
- Are a registered Indian under the Indian Act, or are a child under 2 years who has at least one parent who is a registered Indian under the Indian Act
