NORTHEAST URGENT AND PRIMARY CARE CENTRE (UPCC)


Your family doctor or nurse practitioner knows your health-care needs the best, but if you can't see them, visit the UPCC for same-day, urgent care for non-life-threatening health concerns.



Sprains and strains



Cuts, wounds or skin conditions



High fever



Nausea, diarrhea and constipation



New or worsening pain



Mental health concerns such as low mood, anxiety or depression
