
Public Interest Disclosure Act Annual Report

The *Public Interest Disclosure Act* (PIDA), B.C.'s whistleblower protection law, came into effect at Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) on June 1, 2023. In accordance with PIDA, the following information is reported for the period of April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025:
